REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP WITH SSBC

To become a member, a person shall be eighteen years of age at the time of application and:

- (A) Voluntarily express a genuine interest in being a member of our club.
- (B) Submit a completed application by mail only to the SSBC clubhouse with the appropriate initiation fee, \$50 SSBC club card fee and membership dues at time of application (this does not apply to 'member-in-waiting' status refer to SSBC policy for procedure). Only the sponsoring member may obtain applications.
- (C) All prospective members must have <u>a sponsor who is a member of the club in good standing for more than one year.</u> The sponsoring member agrees to be responsible for mentoring the new member during his/her first year of membership.
- (D) Member applicant will be posted on the club bulletin board for current members to view for a period of 10 days. During this period of 10 days, current members may express any concerns regarding the member applicant to the Vice Commodore. The Vice Commodore shall respond to the member's concern prior to the approval of the applicant.
- (E) The current Bridge shall review all application. Then at least four current Bridge members shall vote to determine to accept the member.
- (F) If membership is not granted the initiation fee, \$50 SSBC club card fee and membership dues would be returned to the requesting individual.
- (G) No prospective member shall be denied membership on the basis of race, sex, national origin, religion, creed, gender, disability, age, or size or type of vessel.
- (H) Membership cards will be distributed yearly after the February 1st deadline by the Membership Secretary and shall be carried by the member at all times.

EXPECTATIONS OF MEMBERS

- (A) A member will pay dues, assessments, \$50 SSBC club card fee and/or un-reimbursed work hours by February 1st of each year he/she is a member.
- **(B)** A member will refrain from actions that would reflect dishonor or disgrace to SSBC or its members.
- (C) A member will comply with SSBC Bylaws and Policies and SSBC Bar Rules.
- **(D)** A member agrees to practice safe boating.
- (E) A member agrees to be an active participant in SSBC.
- (F) A member, when attending an affiliated boat club, will abide by the rules of that club
- (G) Every SSBC member shall be required to put in 10 work hours per calendar year. Members that join during Q3 (July September) will be required to submit 5 work hours that year; 3 work hours will be required of members that join during Q4 (October December). Submitted work hours must be approved by a Board member, committee chairperson or event coordinator. The Membership Secretary will track work hours. Any member that does not complete the required work hours in the calendar year shall be billed \$20.00 per hour for any work hours not fulfilled, to be paid with membership renewal for the following year. Any member that does not pay for their unfulfilled work hours by the time membership renewals are due will be denied membership until payment for work hours is received. If payment for unfulfilled work hours is not received by membership dues deadline the member will have to reapply for membership including payment of a new initiation fee as stated in SSBC Bylaws. Qualifying work would include, but is not limited to, bartending, hosting or helping with an event that is directly put on in whole or part by SSBC, club maintenance (cleaning, painting, carpet cleaning), assistance in receiving orders for the bar, construction, outside yard work and parking area maintenance, editing the monthly SSBC newsletter, maintenance of membership files, serving on standing committees or serving on the Board or other official club service as determined by the Bridge.
